#### **Project work**

The assignment involves a detailed analysis of the Winter Olympics case, specifically examining how to achieve sustainability and create public value through Public-Private collaborations for the planning and execution of mega events and infrastructure development.

Each group will assume the role of an independent advisor to both the Milano Cortina 2026 Foundation and the Milano Cortina 2026 Infrastructure Company.

Each group is tasked with conducting a case analysis and preparing a case brief. This should draw from lecture materials, presentations, site visits, and evidence from both current and past editions of the Winter Olympics and other mega events. The following structure is suggested for your analysis:

- Outline the background and objectives
- Using Moore's strategic triangle:
  - Examine the potential of the games' sustainability and risk management strategies to produce Public Value
  - Assess social and political legitimacy, as well as strategic choices related to stakeholder engagement and collaboration that can enhance the effectiveness of collaborative governance
  - o Evaluate operational and financial sustainability and competencies
- Conclude with lesson learnt and recommendations to your clients

The case study should be prepared as a PowerPoint presentation, containing no more than 10 to 12 slides.

#### **Project Work Discussion Guidelines:**

- Initial discussion and validation of the project work will be carried out by Professor Vecchi and Professor Graddy on Wednesday, May 31st.
- The case will be subsequently presented to external stakeholders the next day.
- Assessment of each group will be based on the quality of the case analysis, the case brief, and the effectiveness of the discussion.
