

WASHINGTON, D.C. SEMESTER PROGRAM

Required Application Materials

1. **APPLICATION COVER SHEET:** (enclosed)
2. **RESUME:** Include education, professional background, relevant courses, volunteer experience, extracurricular activities, honors and awards.
3. **ESSAY:** A one-page, double spaced, type written essay explaining why you want to participate and what you hope to gain from the Washington D.C. semester program. If your cumulative GPA is below a 3.0, please attach a one-page, double spaced, type written statement on your academic abilities to participate in this program.
4. **TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:** One must be an academic recommendation; the other can be either work or personal. If your GPA is below a 3.0, both letters of recommendation must be from academic sources. Please have the letters sent to the attention of Christine Cho: Washington Semester Coordinator, Price School of Public Policy, RGL 108, 650 Childs Way, Los Angeles, CA 90089-0626. *This portion of the application should be completed immediately as there are often delays in acquiring recommendations.*
5. **TRANSCRIPT:** Please visit USC Office of Academic Records and Registrar for a transcript. A copy pulled up through OASIS is not sufficient.
6. **WRITING SAMPLE:** An 'A' paper, re-typed if necessary to remove all typos or spelling errors. It should be short, concise and preferably analytical in nature (3-4 pages). If you are selected as a participant in the program, this will serve as a writing sample for prospective employers.
7. **PROFESSIONAL INTERVIEW:** A professional interview with the Washington Semester Coordinator is required as part of the application process. Students will be contacted to set up an appointment. Students who submit the application early may also make earlier arrangements for an interview.
8. **ARTICULATION AGREEMENT:** Please have your advisor fill out the articulation agreement. This may be obtained from the Washington Semester Coordinator when you are admitted to the program.
9. **INTERNSHIP CHOICES:** Once students are admitted to the Washington Semester program they will be given access to a password protected internship database consisting of 300+ internships. Students will receive resume assistance and advice from the GWU Washington Semester staff and will be encouraged to contact agencies on their own. Background work will be done by GWU so the student would hopefully have an internship secured before arriving in Washington. Please note that USC students may only work 16-20 hours week at the internship due to their course load.

Application Timeline:

Application Deadline: November 1

Interviews: Early November

Decision Notification: Mid-November

NOTE: *Students in USC Housing must notify the housing office of their intent to vacate during spring semester by early November to receive a refund on their deposit. An early application and interview are recommended.*
