- <u>Engemann Student Health Center:</u> Offers a full range of medical services in primary and specialty care, counseling services, health promotion and disease prevention.
- <u>First-Generation Plus Success Center:</u> The First Generation Plus Success Center at USC (FG+SC) serves as a resource hub for current first-generation, undocumented, and former foster youth students as they navigate campus.
- <u>Graduate Student Government:</u> Serves USC graduate and professional students and helps students promote events, finance travel to educational conferences, and provide student organization funding.



- <u>Kortschak Center for Learning and Creativity:</u> Provides enhanced academic support services through individual learning strategy sessions, tutoring in academic disciplines, and assistive technology for students with identified learning disorders.
- <u>LBGT Resource Center:</u> Provides support, education, and advocacy for LGBT and Ally undergraduate and graduate students at USC.
- <u>Libraries Appointment</u>: Schedule a personal meeting with USC librarians to find academic resources
- <u>Living in Los Angeles Guide</u>: A guide to getting around Los Angeles.
- Mindful USC: All mindfulness classes are free to USC students, staff and faculty
- Office of Campus Activities: Sponsors services, programs and events to educate, advocate, entertain and challenge students and oversees over 800 student organizations.
- Office of International Students: Serves international students and visiting scholars through services, programs, and resources.
- Office of Religious and Spiritual Life: Sponsors a variety of opportunities for exploring the spiritual dimensions of your life and learning.
- Recreational Sports: Provides the university community the opportunity to pursue a balanced, healthy lifestyle through participation in recreational activities.
- <u>Relationship and Sexual Violence Prevention and Services:</u> Provides immediate therapy services
 for situations related to gender and power-based harm. On-call counselors aid in discussing
 medical options, reporting options and provide crisis support and advocacy.
- <u>Slack</u>: USC Slack is a collaboration and communication hub for students, faculty and staff that
 helps teams work together and collaborate with people online as efficiently as they do face-toface. With Slack, groups can collaborate within channels that are focused on a specific topic
 which could be a course, a project, a club, a committee or whatever else is needed.
- <u>Student Counseling Services:</u> Dedicated to providing a broad range of quality programs to assist students including short-term psychotherapy, group counseling and crisis intervention.
- <u>Student Judicial Affairs & Community Standards:</u> Investigates and adjudicates matters regarding the USC community standards.
- <u>Student Support and Advocacy:</u> Assists students and families in resolving complex issues which adversely affect a student's academic success and/or collegiate experience.



- <u>SCampus:</u> All students are expected to become familiar with and adhere to the policies, rules, regulations, and standards of conduct outlines in SCampus.
- <u>The Volunteer Center:</u> Dedicated to promoting service within USC, the greater Los Angeles area, and the global community as a whole.
- <u>Trojans Care for Trojans:</u> Provides a private and anonymous service for students to express their concerns about members of the Trojan Family and offers connections to institutional support and resources for Trojans coping with personal difficulties.
