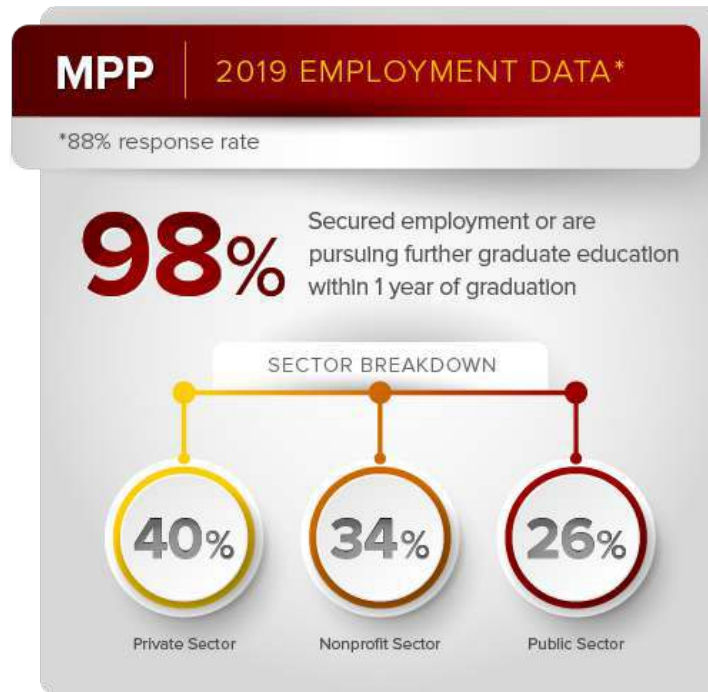


MPP 2019 Employment Data
